ORDINANCE NO. 351

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE SOUTHERLY FIFTEEN FEET OF WEST GRAND STREET, GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls for vacation of the Southerly fifteen (15) feet of West Grand Street more accurately described as follows:

That portion of the Southerly 15.00 feet of West Grand Street lying Westerly of the Westerly right-of-way line of Granite Avenue, according to the plat of the Original Townsite of Granite Falls, as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 99, records of Snohomish County, Washington.

WHEREAS, the petition has been signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the part of such street; and

WHEREAS, the petitioners respectfully represent and allege that the road is not necessary as a part of the general road system and the public will not be inconvenienced by its vacation, and that all of the petitioners are freeholders residing in said Snohomish County and are property owners in the vicinity of said road; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on the 11th day of January, 1984, at 7:30 P.M., before the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, at the Council Chambers at the Town Hall, upon the said petition, pursuant to Resolution No. 83-8 passed at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 14th day of December, 1983, and whereas a good and sufficient Notice of Hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020, was posted in three of the most public places in the Town of Granite Falls, and in a conspicuous place on the street sought to be vacated on the 14th day of December, 1983.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The southerly fifteen (15) feet of West Grand Street, Granite Falls, Washington, more accurately described above, is permanently vacated.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage, publication and posting, according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 11 day of January, 1984.
