ORDINANCE NO. 352

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 340

Amends #340 Sect 1.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 340, REDUCING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO SIX, CREATING THE POSITION OF PLANNING CONSULTANT AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 340 READS AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 1: Creation - Membership: Pursuant to RCW 35.63, there is created a town planning commission, consisting of seven members who shall be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council. Members shall be selected without respect to political affiliations and they shall serve without compensation."

WHEREAS, the Town Planning Commission feels it would be best served by six members and a planning consultant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 340 SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Creation - Membership: Pursuant to RCW 35.63, there is created a town planning commission consisting of six members and a planning consultant, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. Members shall be selected without respect to political affiliations and they shall serve without compensation.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and posting.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 25 day of January, 1984.
