ORDINANCE NO. 353

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 291, TITLE 10, CHAPTER 10.56, SECTION 10.56.050, SUB-PARAGRAPH B AND ADDING SUB-PARAGRAPH G TO TITLE 10, CHAPTER 10.56, SECTION 10.56.050, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Ordinance No. 291, Title 10, Chapter 10.56, Section 10.56.050, Sub-Paragraph B shall be amended to read:

(b). 10 minute parking shall be allowed in front of the Post Office on the north side of Stanley Street between the east and west property lines of the Post Office.

Ordinance No. 291, Title 10, Chapter 10.56, Section 10.56.050, Sub-Paragraph G shall be added to read:

(g). Parking citations may be issued for any parking violations covered under Title 46 of the State of Washington Motor Vehicle Code. Violators of this Ordinance will be subject to fines as set forth by Resolution by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and posting according to law.
