ORDINANCE NO. 355

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SUBSECTION E TO SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 340 (AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND PRESCRIBING ITS DUTIES, AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE).

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

Subsection E shall be added to Section 6 of Ordinance No. 340 to read:

Section 6: Powers of Commissions:

- e. The Planning Commission shall be the "Lead Agency" and/or "Responsible Official" for the Town of Granite Falls pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act as amended. Any decision of the Responsible Official shall be appealable to the Town Council within thirty (30) days of notice.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 10 day of May, 1984.
