

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

ORDINANCE NO. 358

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND OF THE 1984 TAX BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15533.05 FOR PAYMENT OF ONE (1) POLICE VEHICLE, A 1984 VOLVO.

WHEREAS, the Granite Falls Town Council approved purchase of one (1) 1984 Volvo for the Police Department in the amount of \$15533.05 on February 22, 1984;

WHEREAS, the Granite Falls Branch of Rainier Bank has agreed to finance said Volvo for the Town of Granite Falls in the amount of \$15533.05;

WHEREAS, a check was written to the Town of Granite Falls from Rainier Bank for payment to Crown Motors and a warrant was issued by the Town of Granite Falls to Crown Motors in the amount of \$15533.05;

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls will repay Rainier Bank an amount of \$15533.05 in 60 monthly installments; and

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not anticipated nor included in the 1984 Budget;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, the 1984 Tax Budget is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Current Expense Fund, 521.00, shall be increased an amount of \$15533.05 for payment of one (1) 1984 Volvo.

SECTION 2. The Town of Granite Falls shall repay Rainier Bank an amount of \$15533.05 in 60 monthly installments.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and posting.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 26 day of September, 1984.
