## ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE YEAR 1985 IN THE SUM OF \$71,114.00 REGULAR LEVY, \$7200.00 SPECIAL LIBRARY LEVY, AND \$5296.00 SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls with respect to the general levy for the year 1985, the sum of \$71,114.00.

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls for the year 1985, said special levy adopted by the electors of the Town of Granite Falls at an election to be held on the 6th day of November, 1984, the sum of \$7200.00 for Library services.

SECTION 3. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls for the year 1985, said special levy adopted by the electors of the Town of Granite Falls at an election held on the 8th day of November, 1983, the sum of \$5296.00 for Emergency medical services.

SECTION 4. The proceeds of the foregoing regular and special levies are to be placed: \$60495.00 in the Current Expense Fund, \$5296.00 in the Current Expense Fund for Emergency Aid Services, \$10,620.00 in the Street Fund, and \$7200.00 in the Library Fund.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, according to law.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the day of the Town of 1984.
