ORDINANCE NO. 363

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND OF THE 1984 BUDGET BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5207.20 FOR AUDIT FEES.

WHEREAS, The Town of Granite Falls has received reimbursement in the amount of \$5207.20 from Western Casualty and Surety Company for expenses incurred against the Current Expense Fund for Audit Fees; and

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not anticipated nor included in the 1984 Budget;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, the 1984 Budget is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Current Expense Fund, 510.30, shall be increased by an amount of \$5207.20 for payment of Audit Fees.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and posting.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 15 day of November, 1984.
