ORDINANCE NO. 364

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SEWER FUND OF THE 1984 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,955.00 FOR SEWER REVENUE BONDS AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls pays the Sewer Revenue Bond Principal and Interest Account an amount of \$715.00 per month and the Sewer Revenue Bond Reserve Account an amount of \$143.00 per month for the payment of Sewer Revenue Bonds and Interest;

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls Sewer Fund has paid out \$12955.00 for Sewer Revenue Bond and Interest in the year 1984;

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not included in the 1984 Budget;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, the 1984 Budget is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Sewer Fund shall be increased by an amount of \$12955.00 for payment of Sewer Revenue Bond and Interest in the year 1984.

SECTION 2. Funds for this increase are available from payments of the Town to the Sewer Revenue Bond Principal and Interest Account and Reserve Account during the year 1984.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and posting.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 15 day of November, 1984.
