ORDINANCE NO. 365

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON, GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO NORTHWEST GARBAGE CO., INC. FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1985, AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NORTHWEST GARBAGE CO., INC. TO PERFORM GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES WITHIN THE TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED that the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1985, the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, does hereby grant to Northwest Garbage Co., Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Northwest" or "contractor", an exclusive franchise for the collection of garbage and refuse within the corporate municipal limits of the Town of Granite Falls for a period of one (1) year therefrom.

SECTION 2. The town shall enter into a contract or into separate contracts for collection, transportation and disposal covering the exclusive right to collect, remove and/or dispose of solid waste with Northwest Garbage Co., Inc. during the entire term of said franchise.

SECTION 3. The rates to be charged by Northwest shall not exceed the charges set forth in the existing WUTC tariff pages, and rates and charges shall not be changed, amended or modified without 30 days prior notice to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and the Town of Granite Falls.

SECTION 4. Northwest shall provide regular and adequate service to residents and places of business and government facilities desiring its services for the rates set forth in the referenced schedule.

SECTION 5. Northwest shall hold the Town of Granite Falls harmless from and agrees to indemnify the Town of Granite Falls for any and all losses, damages or injuries sustained by the town directly or indirectly, for property damage bodily injury, personal injury or death occasioned by any of the activities of said Northwest, its agents, employees or servants in connection with the operation under this franchise.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and posting in accordance with the law.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 12 day of December, 1984.
