ORDINANCE NO. 367

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 349, THE 1984 BUDGET, TO INCLUDE UNFORSEEN EXPENDITURES IN THE GARBAGE FUND.

WHEREAS, the cost of operating the garbage department was more than anticipated at the adoption of the 1984 Budget; and

WHEREAS, it was the decision of the Granite Falls Town Council to apply the interest from the Money Market Fund to the Garbage Fund; in the amount of \$1432.81;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The current Garbage Fund of the 1984 Budget, shall be amended to shown an increase of \$1432.81. Said money for increase coming from interest of Money Market Fund.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting, according to law.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 20 day of December, 1984.
