ORDINANCE NO. 368 \*

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR SEWER SERVICE WITHIN AND ABOUT THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance Numbers 200, 238, 288, 303 and 304 are hereby amended as the same refer to rates charged for sewer service.

Section 2. The following monthly charges shall be established for sewage treatment and disposal service. Each and every person making use of the Town of Granite Falls sewer shall pay for the same on a residential unit price which shall be established at \$13.00 per unit per month.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 1st day of May, 1985.

Section 4. If any provisions of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY ADOPTED by the Town of Granite Falls this 27 day of March, 1985.
