AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER FUND OF THE 1985 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7735.00 FOR EXPENSES NOT ANTICIPATED NOR INCLUDED IN THE 1985 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the cost of operating the water department was more than anticipated at the adoption of the 1985 Budget; and

WHEREAS, repair to the water system were necessary in 1985 and not anticipated at the adoption of the 1985 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the revenue received in the water fund is greater than anticipated at the adoption of the 1985 Budget;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite FAlls, the 1985 Budget is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The water fund shall be increase by an amount of \$7735.00 for expenses not anticipated nor included in the 1985 Budget.

SECTION 2. The increase to the water fund shall be applied as follows:
