ORDINANCE NO. 375

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2, OF ORDINANCE NO. 241, RELATING TO THE CREATION OF BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS AND ELIGIBILITY.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 241, currently reads:

SECTION 2. Creation of Board of Park Commissioners and Eligibility. There is hereby created a Board of Park Commissioners, consisting of three members who shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the Town Council, from citizens of recognized fitness for such positions who reside in this Town. No Commissioner shall receive any compensation for his services.

WHEREAS, the Town Council feels it is necessary to increase the Board of Park Commissioners to five members;

WHEREAS, The Town Council feels it is not necessary for the members to reside within the Town of Granite Falls;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, that Section 2, of Ordinance No. 241, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Creation of Board of Park Commissioners and Eligibility. There is hereby created a Board of Park Commissioners, consisting of five members who shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the Town Council, from citizens of recognized fitness for such positions who reside in Snohomish County. No Commissioner shall receive any compensation for his services.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, posting, and publication according to law.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 12th day of February, 1986.
