ORDINANCE NO. 387

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DIRECTING AN AMOUNT OF \$1.50 PER UNIT FROM THE WATER FUND, AND EACH \$720.00 HOOKUP FEE TO THE WATER SYSTEM, SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND/WATER" FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER SYSTEM.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The Capital Improvement Fund/Water was established under Ordinance No. 384.

SECTION 2. An amount of \$1.50 per unit from the Water Fund, shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Water along with any other funds the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct.

SECTION 3. Each \$720.00 Hookup Fee to the water system, for new water connections, shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Water along with any other funds the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct.

SECTION 4. Monities in said fund shall be accumulated from year to year, and may be expended at such time as the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct for purposes of making capital improvements to the water system.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 24th day of November, 1986.
