ORDINANCE NO. 389

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 343 AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR SEWER HOOKUP WITHIN AND ABOUT THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.


THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. There shall be a sewer hookup charge of \$550.00 per unit, plus costs of labor and materials.


Section 2. All sewer hookup charges, of \$550.00 per unit, shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Sewer along with any other Funds the Town Council shall by ordinance direct.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the 12 day of December, 1986.
