ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DIRECTING AN AMOUNT OF \$1.00 PER UNIT PER MONTH, SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND/SEWER" FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SEWER SYSTEM.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:


SECTION 1. The Capital Improvement Fund/Sewer was established under Ordinance NO. 388.

SECTION 2. An amount of \$1.00 per unit per month from the Sewer Fund, shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Sewer along with any other funds the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct.

SECTION 3. Monities in said fund shall be accumulated from year to year, and may be expended at such time as the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct for purposes of making capital improvments to the sewer system.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 2 day of April, 1987.
