ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS CLOSING THE PARK FUND AND APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF THE RESIDUAL EQUITY TO THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:


Section 1. The Park Fund shall be closed effective January 1, 1985.

Section 2. The residual equity in the amount of \$323.00 shall be transferred to the Current Expense Fund.


Section 3. Park accounts shall be included in the Current Expense Fund.
