ORDINANCE NO. 395

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS CLOSING THE GARBAGE FUND AND APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF THE RESIDUAL EQUITY EQUALLY TO THE STREET FUND, WATER FUND, AND SEWER FUND.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:


Section 1. Garbage Service in the Town of Granite Falls was terminated on December 31, 1984.

Section 2. The Garbage Fund shall be closed effective March 1, 1985.


Section 3. The residual equity in the amount of \$3579.98 shall be transferred as follows: \$1193.33 to City Streets, \$1193.33 to Water, and \$1193.32 to Sewer.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 29 day of April, 1987.
