

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

ORDINANCE NO. 396

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS COMBINING THE OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER WITH THE OFFICE OF TOWN CLERK PURSUANT TO R.C.W. 32.28.180 AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls, Snohomish County, Washington, is a municipal corporation of the Fourth Class; and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 35.27.180 provides that the office of Treasurer and Clerk may be combined and the office of Town Treasurer abolished; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be the best interest of the Town and for efficiency and economy that a consolidation of said office be effected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, as follows.

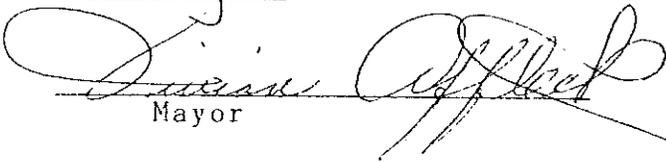
Section 1. That the Office of Treasurer of the Town of Granite Falls be combined with that of Clerk of the Town of Granite Falls, and that the effective date when the consolidation shall take place shall be the 1st day of September, 1987.

Section 2. The Office of Town Treasurer shall be and it is hereby combined with the Office of Town Clerk and the Office of Town Clerk and the Office of Town Treasurer is hereby abolished.

Section 2. Henceforth the consolidated office shall be designated Town Clerk-Treasurer, and in such capacity the Clerk shall exercise all the powers and perform all the duties required by statute or ordinance to be performed by the two offices.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law, and the offices of Treasurer and Clerk shall be deemed combined from and after the expiration of three (3) months from the date when this Ordinance becomes effective.
