ORDINANCE NO. 397

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 279 AS CODIFIED IN SECTION 9.04.050 OF THE GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE COMMISSION OF MISDEMEANORS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls that Section 9.04.050 of the Granite Falls Municipal Code, which presently reads as follows:

9.04.050 Classification of crimes--Penalties. All offenses defined by this title or by any state statute which is incorporated hereby by reference, constitute crimes and are hereby classified as misdemeanors. Any person convicted of having committed such a misdemeanor shall be punished by imprisonment for a term not to exceed six months, or by a fine not to exceed \$500, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Provided, however, certain misdemeanors specified in this title shall be punishable solely by a fine not to exceed \$500.

is hereby amended to read as follows:


9.04.050 Classification of crimes--Penalties: All offenses defined by this title or any state statute which is incorporated or adopted by reference, constitute crimes and are hereby classified as misdemeanors. Any person convicted of having committed such a misdemeanor shall be punished by imprisonment for a maximum term fixed by the court of not more than 90 days, or by a fine in an amount fixed by the court of not more than \$1,000, or by both such imprisonment and fine. Provided, however, certain misdemeanors specified in this title shall be punishable solely by a fine not to exceed \$500 if so provided in said section.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town Council believes there is insufficient time to bring this Ordinance on for three

readings and therefore declares an emergency to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective upon becoming valid.




