ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS CREATING  
A NEW FUND TO BE ENTITLED "EQUIPMENT FUND" FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF REPLACEMENT OF CITY EQUIPMENT AS NEEDED.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN:

Section 1. There is hereby created and established a special fund,  
to be known and designated as "Equipment Fund".


Section 2. The Equipment Fund shall be accumulated for purchase  
of City Equipment as designated by Council by Resolution.

Section 3. Funding of the Equipment Fund shall be as designated  
by Council by Resolution.

Section 4. Monies in said fund may be accumulated from year to  
year, included in the yearly budget, and will be expended as  
directed by Resolution.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of November, 1987.
