ORDINANCE NO. 424

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 151, AS CODIFIED IN CHAPTER 5.28, OF THE GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 151 was previously adopted providing for the requirement that any persons, companies or corporations or associations transacting, exercising or engaging in a business directly or indirectly within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls, of any trade or occupation or business, be required to have a business license; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 151 made it unlawful for anyone to engage in business without securing a business license; and

WHEREAS, no further specific penalty was provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls as follows:


SECTION 1: There is hereby added to Chapter 5.28 a new section to be known as Section 5.28.080, to read as follows:

5.28.080 Penalty. Any person, company, corporation or association engaged in business in the Town of Granite Falls as provided in Section 5.28.010 without a lawfully issued business license shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for a term not to exceed six (6) months, and/or a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00.

SECTION 2: Insufficient time exists in which to allow the readings of this Ordinance, and the Town Council declares that an emergency exists requiring the immediate passage of said ordinance, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
