ORDINANCE NO. 431

AN ORDINANCE STATING THE INTENTION OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS TO BE ANNEXED BY SNOHOMISH COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 17.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls wishes to unify the delivery of fire protection services under one authority;

WHEREAS, Snohomish County Fire District No. 17 can best serve as the unified authority for the delivery of fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, such unification is in the public interest and for the public benefit in terms of providing more effective services, equal rates for Town and non-Town residents, and allow voters of the Town a vote in Fire District issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, as follows:

1. The Town of Granite Falls hereby states its intent to join Snohomish County Fire District No. 17 pursuant to RCW 52.04.061.
2. The Town of Granite Falls declares that the public interest will be served by such annexation.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
