ORDINANCE NO. 439

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND OF THE 1990 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4321.00 FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS INCURRED IN THE REPLACEMENT OF POLICE OFFICER WHILE SAID OFFICER ATTENDED THE BASIC LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has received reimbursement in the amount of \$4321.00 from the State of Washington for reimbursement of costs incurred in the replacement of Michael Tow while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy;

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not included in the 1990 Budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, the 1990 Budget is amended as follows:


SECTION 1. The Current Expense Fund, 521.00.10 - Law Enforcement Salaries and Wages shall be increased by an amount of \$3963.00 for wages incurred in the replacement of Michael Tow while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy;

SECTION 2. The Current Expense Fund, 521.00.10 - Law Enforcement Benefits, shall be increased by an amount of \$358.00 for benefits incurred in the replacement of Michael Tow while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy;

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 26 day of September, 1990.
