ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS ADDING A SECTION TO ORDINANCE NO. 278 (AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING INTERIM STANDARDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS).

WHEREAS, on May 23, 1979, the Granite Falls Town Council adopted the Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction prepared by the Washington State Chapter of the American Public Works Association for the construction of streets within the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, the above standards do not require sidewalks to be provided along all permanent cul-de-sacs longer than 400 feet, if the plat density is less than three and one half (3.5) dwelling units per acre; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council feels that sidewalks should be provided along all permanent cul-de-sacs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Sidewalks shall be provided along all permanent cul-de-sacs.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage, posting and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 26 day of September, 1990.
