ORDINANCE NO. 460

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DIRECTING AN AMOUNT OF \$4.00 PER UNIT FROM THE WATER FUND, AND EACH \$2,000.00 HOOKUP FEE TO THE WATER SYSTEM AND AN ADDITIONAL \$1,000.00 PER UNIT FOR HOOKUPS OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS, SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND/WATER" FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER SYSTEM.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 384 establishing the Capital Improvement Fund/Water, Ordinance No. 433 and Ordinance No. 456 revising the charges are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. An amount of \$4.00 per unit from the Water Fund shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Water along with any other funds the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct. A portion (\$2.00) of the \$4.00 per unit amount will be used for the purpose of installation of meters to all non-metered water services. At such time when all water services are metered, the \$2.00 charge will be eliminated.

SECTION 3. Each \$2,000.00 Hookup Fee to the water system, for new water connections and an additional \$1,000.00 per unit for hookups outside of the City limits, shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund/Water along with any other funds the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct.

SECTION 4. 500 cubic feet of water shall be allowed during the construction of a residential, apartment or commercial structure.

SECTION 5. Monities in said fund shall be accumulated from year to year, and may be expended at such time as the Town Council shall by Ordinance direct for purposes of making capital improvements to the water system.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 1st day of March, 1991.
