ORDINANCE NO. 471

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND/STREET OF THE 1991 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8500.00 DUE TO EXPENSES GREATER THAN ANTICIPATED IN THE 1991 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls used Revenue received from State shared Revenue in the Capital Improvement Fund/Street that was shown as ending cash on the 1991, Budget; and

WHEREAS, expenditures in the Capital Improvement Fund/Street have exceeded the amount budgeted in the 1991 Budget;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, the 1991 Budget for the Capital Improvement Fund/Street is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Capital Improvement Fund/Street, 542.00.00, Capital Improvements and Professional Services, shall be increased by an amount of \$8500.00 for expenses greater than anticipated.

SECTION 2. Capital Improvement Fund/Street, Ending Cash and Investments shall be reduced by an amount of \$8500.00.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 19 day of December, 1991.
