ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS RESTRICTING THE USE OF FIREWORKS.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Granite Falls feels the restriction of the use of fireworks is in the best interest of the public due to dry weather and extremely high fire danger; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to adopt an Ordinance restricting the use of any and all fireworks to July 4; and

WHEREAS, the Council feels and emergency exists and there is insufficient time for multiple readings of the Ordinance: now, therefore,

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE

In order to insure safety for the public and eliminate fire danger for the residents of the Town of Granite Falls, the use of any and all fireworks shall be allowed only on July 4 between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M.

SECTION 2. PENALTIES

Failure to comply with this Ordinance is designated as a violation and shall constitute a criminal offense and can be punishable by fine and/or imprisonment.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION

Because of the reasons stated above, this Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force upon passage as provided by law.
