ORDINANCE NO. 505

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND OF THE 1993 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3784.00 FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS INCURRED IN THE REPLACEMENT OF POLICE OFFICER WHILE SAID OFFICER ATTENDED THE BASIC LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY.

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls has received reimbursement in the amount of \$3784.00 from the State of Washington for reimbursement of costs incurred in the replacement of James Maples while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy:

WHEREAS, this expenditure was not included in the 1993 Budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, the 1993 Budget is amended as follows:


SECTION 1. The Current Expense Fund, 521.00.10 - Law Enforcement Salaries and Wages, shall be increased by an amount of \$3520.00 for wages incurred in the replacement of James Maples while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy.


SECTION 2. The Current Expense Fund, 521.00.20 - Law Enforcement Benefits, shall be increased by an amount of \$264.00 for benefits incurred in the replacement of James Maples while attending the Basic Law Enforcement Academy.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the city Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 28 day of July, 1993.
