ORDINANCE NO. 521

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE WASHINGTON MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (MTO) AS CONTAINED IN THE WASHINGTON ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, CH. 308-330 WAC, TO REGULATE TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 291, SECTION 2.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has provided that Ch. 46.90 RCW, which contained the Washington MTO, will expire on July 1, 1994, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Washington MTO have been readopted in the Washington Administrative Code in Ch. 308-330 WAC, which will become effective on July 1, 1994; now,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION BY REFERENCE. The "Washington Model Traffic Ordinance," Ch. 308-330 Wac, and Section 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, and 12 of Chapter 275, Laws of 1994, or as hereafter codified in the RCW and/or WAC, is hereby adopted by reference as the traffic ordinance of the City of Granite Falls as if set forth in full.

Section 2. SECTIONS NOT ADOPTED. The following sections of the MTO are not adopted by reference and are expressly deleted.

Section 3. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 291, Section 2, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE. The repeal of Ordinance No. 291, Section 2, does not affect any pending or existing litigation and does not operate as an abatement or bar to any action or proceeding pending under or by virtue of the repealed ordinance.

Section 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
