ORDINANCE NO. 530

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND OF THE 1994 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$135,000.00 DUE TO REVENUES AND EXPENSES GREATER THAN ANTICIPATED IN THE 1994 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls has received Revenue from planning/engineering fees and building permits greater than anticipated when preparing the 1994 Budget; and

WHEREAS, expenditures in the Current Expense Fund have exceeded the amount budgeted in the 1994 Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, the 1994 Budget for the Current Expense Fund is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Current Expense Fund shall be increased by an amount of \$135,000.00, as detailed on page 2 of this Ordinance, for expenses greater than anticipated.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the City Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 28 day of December, 1994.
