ORDINANCE NO. 544

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING SNOHOMISH COUNTY TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION - ANNEXATION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS INTO THE SNO-ISLE REGIONAL LIBRARY SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, Granite Falls City Council has requested to be annexed into the Sno-Isle Regional Library System; and

WHEREAS, Sno-Isle Regional Library System has approved this request; and

WHEREAS, Granite Falls City Council has determined it would be in the best interest of the public to be annexed into Sno-Isle Regional Library System.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Granite Falls City Council requests the Snohomish County Council to place on the ballot of the Primary Election, to be held September 19, 1995, the following form: "Shall the City of Granite Falls be annexed to and be a part of Sno-Isle Regional Library System?"

Section 2. Effective Date/Public Emergency Ordinance.

Pursuant to RCW 35A.12.130, the Council designates this Ordinance to be a Public Emergency Ordinance necessary for the protection of public health, public safety, public property or the public peace, and shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
