ORDINANCE NO. 580

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS,
WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A POLICY OF CIVIL RIGHTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DO HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Policy Statement – It is the policy of the City of Granite Falls that no person will, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap, be excluded from participation in or be subjected to discrimination in any program or activity funded, in whole or in part, by federal funds or local funds.

Section 2. Compliance Procedure – All contracts funded with federal grant monies will contain a clause to prohibit the contractor from discriminating on the grounds of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap.

Section 3. Compliance Officer – The City Clerk will be the compliance officer.

Section 4. Severability – If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held invalid for any reason, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date – This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its publication.
