ORDINANCE NO. 583

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR RECYCLING RATES WITHIN THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls desires to begin mandatory Curb Side Recycling in the City of Granite Falls and discontinue the Drop Box Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, the cost to retain the Drop Box Recycling Program has drastically increased; and

WHEREAS, the cost for Curb Side Recycling would be less than the cost to maintain the Drop Box Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, contaminated material is being placed in the drop boxes and garbage is left in the drop box area; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County is reducing the portion of the costs they pay to maintain the Drop Box Recycling Program in Granite Falls;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 487 is hereby amended changing the Drop Box Recycling Program to mandatory Curb Side Recycling and amending the rates.

Section 2. The City shall collect charges for recycling services within the City of Granite Falls for residential and multi family residential customers only. All revenue collected for recycling service shall be paid to the Solid Waste Fund.

Section 3. Rates and Charges.

The following rates and charges are

<u>Classification</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
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RESIDENTIAL USE:

Single-family residence (1-unit)	\$3.50
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Multi-family residence (1-unit)	\$3.50
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Additional units (per each unit)	\$3.50
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Section 4. Billing of Charges. Monthly recycling charges will be billed on the same customer statement used for water, sewer and storm drainage charges and the same billing and collection policy will be used as is used for the water, sewer and storm drainage funds.

Section 5. Collection of Charges. Monies from the monthly recycling charge will be accumulated and used to pay for recycling disposal costs incurred by the City.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective on the last day of December, 1997.
