ORDINANCE NO. 601

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING CHAPTER 15.02 OF THE GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL
CODE, THE CITY COUNCIL DO HEREBY ODAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Chapter 15.02. of the Granite Falls Municipal Code, covering
Uniform Codes and fee schedules under Uniform Codes shall be amended
to read as follows:**

15.02. 010 Short title.
This title shall be known as the building code of the City of Granite Falls.

15.02. 020 Adoption of uniform codes.
**The following Uniform Codes and Standards, one copy of each of which
has been filed or is on file at Granite Falls City Hall for inspection by the
public, which has been adopted with amendments by the State Building
Code Council pursuant to Chapter 19.27 RCW are herewith adopted by
reference as tough fully set forth in this chapter.**

- 1. Uniform Building Code Volumes I, II, and III, published by the
International Conferences of Building Officials, 1997 Editions,
together with amendments as set forth in chapter 51-40 WAC are
adopted in their entirety as the building code of the city.**
- 2. Uniform Mechanical Code, published by the International
Conference of Building Officials, 1997 Editions, together with
amendments as set forth in Chapter 51-42 WAC are adopted in their
entirety as the mechanical code of the City.**

3. Uniform Plumbing Code and Uniform Plumbing Code Standards, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 1997 Editions, together with amendments as set forth in Chapter 51-46 and 51-47 WAC are adopted in their entirety as the plumbing code of the City.
4. Uniform Fire Code Volumes I and II, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 1997 Editions, together with amendments as set forth in chapters 51-44 and 51-45 WAC are adopted in their entirety as the fire code of the City.
5. Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, published by the International Conference of building Officials, 1997 Edition, are adopted in its entirety.
6. Washington State Energy Code, published by the Washington State Building Code Council, 1997 Edition, as set forth in Chapter 51-11 WAC are adopted in its entirety.
7. Washington State Ventilation and Indoor Air Quality Code, 1997 Edition, as set forth in Chapter 51-13 WAC are adopted in its entirety.

15.02. 030 Schedule of fees under Uniform Codes.
All fees shall be as provided in the 1997 Edition of the Uniform Codes.

15.02. 040 Penalty for violation.
In addition to the administrative remedies provided for in this title, any person found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in violation or to have violated any mandatory provisions of this title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of \$1,000 and/or 90 days in jail. Each day that a violation is found to exist shall be deemed a separate offense.

14.02. 050 Conflicting provisions.
If any term, provision, condition or other portion of the codes is held to be inoperative, invalid, or unenforceable, the remainder of the code or the application of the terms or provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid or unenforceable shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. If there is conflicting terms, provisions, or conditions between the codes, the more restrictive requirements shall prevail.
