## CITY OF GRANITE FALLS **ORDINANCE NO 617**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE DEPOSITION OF THE REAL ESTATE EXCISE TAX PROCEEDS FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND WATER TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND SEWER.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance Numbers 383 and 518 are hereby amended as the same refers to the deposition of Real Estate Excise Tax.

SECTION 2. All proceeds of the excise tax which are disbursed to the City shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund Sewer. Monies in said fund shall be accumulated from year to year, and may be expended at such time as the City Council directs for purposes of making capital improvements to the waste water treatment plant.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective on the first day of April. 2000.
