ORDINANCE NO. 629

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 555, AND CHAPTER 13.16 OF THE GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE.

Chapter 13.16.256 of the Granite Falls Municipal Code, covering rates and charges – meter installation shall be amended to add item D. to read as follows:

- D. A separate water line for fire suppression may be installed to the property. Installation of a check valve with meter will be required. All costs for materials and labor will be borne by the owner of the property. A tap fee or monthly service fee will not be charged for a separate water line that only services the fire suppression system. If any water usage occurs through this system, the property owner will be charged the per 100 cu ft. rate as stated in this ordinance.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 13 day of September, 2000.


