ORDINANCE NO. 636

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND WATER OF THE 2000 BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$64128.23, DUE TO NEW CONSTRUCTION IN 2000 THAT WAS GREATER THAN ANTICIPATED.

WHEREAS, revenue collected from Tap Fees generated from new construction was greater than anticipated.

WHEREAS, payments made to Snohomish County PUD, as stipulated in our contract with PUD, from Tap Fees collected by the City were also greater than budgeted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, the 2000 Budget for the Capital Improvement Fund Water is amended as follows:


SECTION 1. Capital Improvement Fund/Water Expenditures, 590.00, Tap Fee Payment – P.U.D., shall be increased by \$64128.23.

SECTION 2. Capital Improvement Fund/Water, Tap Fee Revenues, 340.00, shall be increased by \$64128.23.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 19 day of December, 2000.
