ORDINANCE NO. 647

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AMENDING THE 2001 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND STREET BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28470.00 DUE TO ENGINEERING SERVICES. GREATER THAN ANTICIPATED.

WHEREAS, the CIF Street Fund 2001 Budget Revenues shall be increased due to receipt of a Small City Pavement Preservation Grant.

WHEREAS, Engineering expenditures exceeded what was anticipated for the 2001 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, the 2001 Budget for the CIF Street Fund is amended as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> CIF Street Fund expenditures, 542.30.41, Professional Services, Engineer, of the 2001 Budget shall be increased by \$28470.00.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> CIF Street Fund revenue, 334.03.61, small city pavement preservation grant, was received for \$50,000.00.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon its approval, passage and publication.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 3 day of December, 2001.
