#### **ORDINANCE NO. 857-2013**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, AMENDING THE GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE CH 6.16 ADDING A NEW SECTION 6.16.005 ENTITLED "STATUTES INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE," REPEALING SECTION 6.16.030 ENTITLED "UNLAWFUL DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE - PENALTY"-PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

# NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> A new section, GFMC 6.16.005 entitled "Statutes incorporated by reference" is hereby added to read as follows:

Statutes incorporated by reference.

70.95.240	Unlawful to dump or deposit solid waste without permit –
	Penalties – Litter cleanup restitution payment.
70.95.500	Disposal of vehicle tires outside designated area prohibited –
Penalty Exemption.	
70.95.610	Battery disposal – Restrictions – Violators subject to fine –
	"Vehicle battery" defined.

<u>Section 2.</u> GFMC Section 6.16.030 entitled "Unlawful disposal of solid waste – Penalty" is hereby repealed.

## 6.16.030 Unlawful disposal of solid waste Penalty.

- (A) It is unlawful for any person to dispose of any solid waste generated in the city of Granite Falls and subject to this chapter unless they comply with the provisions of RCW 70.95.240, 70.95.500, and 70.95.610, which are hereby adopted by reference.
- (B) Any violation of the provisions of RCW 70.95.240 shall be a misdemeanor, and any person found guilty thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000 or imprisonment in jail not to exceed 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- (C) Any violation of the provisions of RCW 70.95.610 shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.
- (D) Any violation of the provisions of RCW 70.95.500 shall be punishable by a civil penalty, which shall be no less than \$200.00, nor more than \$2,000 for each offense. [Ord. 436 § 3, 1990.]
- Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.
