**ORDINANCE NO. 870-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS WASHINGTON REPEALING CHAPTER 2.34 GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE "CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION - POLICE"**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Granite Falls has negotiated and entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish County, Washington to provide police services within the City effective March 1, 2014;

**WHEREAS**, there are no pending appeals, requests for investigation, or other matters pending or that could be timely filed with the Granite Falls Civil Service Commission – Police;

**Now, therefore, the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, Washington do ordain as follows:**


**Section 1.** Chapter 2.34 Granite Falls Municipal Code "CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION - POLICE" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its publication or publication of the summary consisting of the title. The designation and appointment of a chief law enforcement officer shall be in effect upon execution of the Interlocal Agreement with the contract agency.

Said Ordinance was passed in open session by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls on the 2nd day of April, 2014, and signed in authentication of its passage this 2nd day of April, 2014.
