## **ORDINANCE NO. 872-2014**

## CITY OF GRANITE FALLS

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE GRANITE FALLS ALTERNATE ROUTE AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Snohomish County and the City of Granite Falls partnered to design and construct Quarry Road (a.k.a. Granite Falls Alternate Route (GFAR)), a new road alignment, that intersects SR 92 to the west of the City and connects with the Mountain Loop Highway, a County road; and

WHEREAS, portions of Quarry Road are located both in the City and in unincorporated Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, from the project's beginning the City, the County, and the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) intended that the GFAR would become part of SR 92 upon the completion of construction; and

WHEREAS, the agreement also stipulates that a portion of SR 92 within the City and unincorporated portion of the County will become City and County road,

WHEREAS, construction of Quarry Road is complete and the road was opened to vehicular traffic on November 19, 2010, and;

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Transportation, Snohomish County and the City of Granite Falls are entering into an agreement, No. GCB 1289, to allow Quarry Road to be included as part of the State highway system as a partially controlled limited access facility,

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as findings of fact and conclusions as if set forth in full herein, approves Agreement No. GCB 1289 and authorizes the Mayor to sign said Agreement.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Publication and Summary.</u> This Ordinance or summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days' after publication of the summary consisting of the title.
