

ORDINANCE NO. 880-2014

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON
REPEALING CHAPTER 2.16 "TREASURER" AND AMENDING
CHAPTER 2.12 RETITLING IT "CLERK-TREASURER" TO
CONSOLIDATE THE POSITIONS OF CITY CLERK AND CITY
TREASURER**

The city council of the city of Granite Falls, Washington do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2.16 Granite Falls Municipal Code "Treasurer" is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Chapter 2.12 Granite Falls Municipal Code is hereby retitled "Clerk Treasurer" and amended to read as follows:

**Chapter 2.12
CITY CLERK-TREASURER**

2.12.010 Created.

The offices of city treasurer and city clerk are combined into the single office of city clerk-treasurer in the city of Granite Falls.

2.12.020 Appointment

The mayor shall appoint a clerk treasurer who shall hold office at the pleasure of the mayor, as provided by the laws of the state of Washington

2.12.030 Oath - Bond

The clerk treasurer, before entering upon the duties of the office, shall file an oath of office and execute a bond approved by the council in such sum as the council by ordinance may determine, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties, including in the same bond the duties of both the clerk and treasurer and all other offices of which the clerk is made ex officio incumbent. The bond of the clerk treasurer will be filed with the mayor or designee.

2.12.040 Duties


The clerk treasurer shall keep all books and records of the city and perform such duties as are required by the provisions of the laws of the state of Washington for both a city clerk and a city treasurer. The clerk treasurer shall perform all such other duties required by ordinance or resolution passed by the city council now existing or hereafter adopted.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of the Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of the publication.


Said Ordinance was passed by the city council at a regular meeting thereof on the 3rd day of Sept. 2014.


