ORDINANCE NO. 903-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE 2016 ANNUAL BUDGET PROVIDING ESTIMATED REVENUES AND APPROPRIATED EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, State law requires cities to adopt a 2016 budget no later than December 31, 2015, and provides procedures for filing estimates, a preliminary budget, public hearings, and final fixing of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held workshops and invited public comment on the preliminary budget for 2015 on September 9, 2015, October 14, 2015, November 18, 2015, and December 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the City of Granite Falls (the "City") for the purposes set forth in said budget.

WHEREAS, the estimated expenditures set forth in the budget are all necessary to carry on the government of the City for the 2016 calendar year and are sufficient to meet the various needs of the City during said period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council after due notice, held a public hearing on December 2, 2015, to consider 2016 revenue sources and expenditure appropriations for the year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has deliberated on the proposed 2016 budget and made adjustments and changes deemed necessary and proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Adoption by Reference.</u> The annual budget for the City of Granite Falls, Washington, for the year 2016 is hereby adopted at the fund level in its final form and content as set forth in the document entitled City of Granite Falls 2016 Annual Budget, one copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

<u>Section 2.</u> Resources and Expenditures. Estimated resources for each separate fund of the City of Granite Falls, and aggregate expenditures for all such funds for the year 2016 are set forth in summary form below, and are hereby appropriated for expenditure at the fund level during the year 2016 as set forth in the City of Granite Falls 2016 Annual Budget.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Repealer</u>. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, of the City of Granite Falls in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Publication and Summary</u>. This Ordinance or summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City.

<u>Section 7</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of the summary consisting of the title.
