

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE KEEPING OR MAINTAINING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS OF ANY BAWDY HOUSE, HOUSE OF ILL FAME OR ANY PLACE FOR THE PRACTICE OF PROSTITUTION OR LEWDNESS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: Whoever shall keep or maintain within the corporate limits of the town of Granite Falls any bawdy house, house of ill fame or any place for the practice of prostitution or lewdness or shall knowingly permit any building or place owned by him or her, or under his or her control to be used for that purpose, shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 and the costs of prosecution which costs shall be a part of the fine, or by imprisonment not more than 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 2: Whoever shall be an inmate of any bawdy house, house of ill fame or any place for the practice of prostitution or lewdness or shall in any way contribute to the support thereof or be connected therewith or whoever shall be found therein shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$50 together with the costs of prosecution which costs shall be a part of the fine or be imprisoned not less than 2 nor more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in effect and full force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
