## CITY OF GRANITE FALLS ORDINANCE NO. 951-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON AMENDING GRANITE FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE SECTON 3.24.030 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND/SEWER TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF ONGOING CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FUND FROM THE SEWER FUND

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Granite Falls Municipal Code Section 3.24.030 entitled "Capital Improvement Fund/Sewer" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.24.030 Capital Improvement fund/sewer.

- (A) There is created and established a special fund, to be known and designated as "capital improvement fund/sewer."
- (B) An amount of \$1.00 per unit per month from the sewer fund shall be deposited into the capital improvement fund/sewer along with any other funds the city council shall by ordinance direct.
- (C) (B) Monies in said fund shall be accumulated from year to year and may be expended at such time as the city council shall direct for purposes of making capital improvements to the sewer system.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its publication by summary.
