## CITY OF GRANITE FALLS

## **ORDINANCE NO. 967-2019**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE 2019 CITY BUDGET; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 961-2018 ADOPTING THE 2019 BUDGET TO ADJUST REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR FUNDS AS INCLUDED ON EXHIBIT "A".

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Granite Falls, Washington (the "City") adopted the 2019 Budget by Ordinance No. 961-2018 on November 21, 2018, establishing necessary and proper allocations for each department and fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of revenue and appropriation allocations can only be estimated at the time of finalization of the budget; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council has determined it is necessary to make further adjustments in the budget to adjust the revenues to reflect:

- Increase in the CIF Sewer Fund Beginning Balance Adjust to actual.
- Increase in the Storm Fund Beginning Balance Adjust to actual.
- Increase in the Storm Fund Stormwater Capacity Toxics Grant Adjust to actual.
- Increase in the CIF Storm Fund Beginning Balance Adjust to actual.

**WHEREAS,** the City Council has determined it is necessary to make further adjustments in the budget to adjust the expenditures to reflect:

- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Sewer Fund Projected cost for building roof repairs.
- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Sewer Fund Cost associated with demo burn of the church/barn on 408 Prospect.
- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Sewer Fund Projected 2019 Effluent Piping costs.
- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Sewer Fund Projected Interim Liquid Stream Improvements costs.
- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Sewer Fund Projected WWTP Design costs.
- Adjust Capital Expenditures in CIF Storm Fund Projected Water quality Improvements for Frank Mason Parking Lot.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Amendment of 2019 Budget and Appropriation of Funds.</u> The 2019 annual budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 961-2018 for the period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019, is hereby further amended by fund to reflect the adjustments to revenue estimates and appropriations in accordance with the attached and incorporated Exhibit A and the Budgetary Position List Exhibit B attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and instructed to make the necessary changes to the 2019 annual budget adopted by Ordinance No. 961-2018 and make any necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the amendments contained in this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Ordinance No. 961-2018 is hereby amended as necessary to reflect the budget amendments contained in this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.
- <u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of the publication.
