

RESOLUTION NO. 10-77

A RESOLUTION FOR THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CAUSE TO BE PREPARED AND SUBMIT TO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR A WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT AMENDMENTS OF 1972; FURTHER DESIGNATING THE MAYOR AS THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE TOWN TO SIGN AND ATTEST ALL DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH SAID APPLICATION AND TO ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN ANY GRANT THEREUNDER.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON DO RESOLVE:

Section 1. The Mayor of the Town of Granite Falls is hereby authorized to cause to be prepared and to submit on behalf of the Town of Granite Falls, to the State of Washington Department of Ecology, an application for Federal assistance for a wastewater treatment facility to comply with the requirements of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972.

Section 2. The Mayor of the Town of Granite Falls is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the Town to sign and attest all documents in connection with said application, and to accept on behalf of the Town any grant thereunder.
