

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASH. --- RESOLUTION 82-3

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN INTERMEDIARY TO ACT UNDER THE MAYOR'S DIRECTION
IN OBTAINING AND CONDUCTING THE 1982 ARCHITECTURAL/BUSINESS SURVEY THROUGH
FUNDING AVAILABLE FROM THE RENOVATION AND RESTORATION GRANT.

WHEREAS a licensed architect will be required for the summer of 1982 to conduct surveys and develop renderings, and

WHEREAS the mayor, Bernie Fleming, has been the town's government contact person for the Restoration and Renovation Committee since its inception, and

WHEREAS a certain expertise is required in the obtaining of proper personnel for the conduct and administration of the architectural survey,

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASH., DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The town council does appoint Mr. Brent Lambert of the Snohomish County Planning Dept. to act as the intermediary in negotiations and locating of an appropriate architect.

Section 2. The mayor, Bernie Fleming, shall continue to act as the government representative for the Town of Granite Falls and shall act in a decisional capacity for the town in regards to the renovation and restoration process. Mayor Fleming shall report to council any and all major events during the report period of the regular council meeting.

Section 3. Mayor Fleming and Brent Lambert shall make the architect selection on the basis of their judgement towards obtaining the most experienced and historically motivated personnel available for the funding supplied. Their decision will be final, but will be reported to council with supportive figures and facts.

Section 4. For the purposes of this resolution, the Restoration and Renovation Project is also known by the following other titles: Restoration and Revitalization Project, Renovation and Restoration Project.

Section 5. This resolution becomes null and void, unless renewed by council, on December 31, 1982.
