



The Project Description for the years 1981, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986 will not be changed, as a result of this Amendment. The Amendment will revise the 1982 Miscellaneous Paving. The Amendment provides for light bituminous surface treatment, seal coating, gravel shoulders and drainage. The projects listed under 1982 Miscellaneous Street Improvements are those within the Sewer System Rehabilitation Project, as well as the first three projects presently listed under 1982 Miscellaneous Paving on the existing Six Year Street Arterial Program. Additional projects which are presently not paved and/or in need of repair are also listed.
